- Work in diverse, high-quality natural areas monitoring rare species of plants and/or animals and learning identification and reporting procedures.
- Work with professional staff from other state agencies, federal agencies, and/or non-profit organizations.
- 9 weeks, \$420 per week (37.5 hrs/week)
- Late May through Early August 2021
- Temporary (seasonal), 2 positions anticipated

**Requirements**

Successful applicants will be expected to safely use and maintain power equipment such as chainsaws (gas or electric), pole saws, brushcutters, hand tools, UTVs, trucks, trucks towing loaded trailers, pumps, etc. Work at times will be in remote areas with little supervision. Expect biting insects and carrying heavy loads on uneven terrain. Sturdy work boots with ankle support will be needed. Safety equipment will be provided.
