

JOB DESCRIPTION

Consulting Utility Forester (CUF)

Nature of Duties:

- 1. Identification, inspection, and evaluation of trees and brush along utility lines.
- 2. Submit inspection results to clients with recommendations.
- 3. Plan, direct, and coordinate the activities of assigned line-clearance crews.
- 4. Discuss and negotiate line-clearance crew access issues.
- 5. Serve as a liaison between clients, tree crews, and client customers.
- 6. Safeguards employees and public from hazards in and around the work area.
- 7. Helps enforce on-the-job safety practices.
- 8. Carries and utilizes materials, tools, and equipment at work site.
- 9. Services truck and equipment. Keeps trucks and other assigned equipment in a neat and orderly fashion. Reports the need for equipment and truck repairs to supervisor.
- 10. Performs other related duties as required or assigned.

Requirements:

- 1. Degree or experience in Forestry, Arboriculture, Horticulture, Biology, Environmental Sciences, Natural Resources, Conservation, or related fields.
- 2. One or more years of field related experience.
- 3. ISA Certification, or be able to obtain within one year from date of employment.
- 4. Superior species identification skills and invasive species knowledge, plus knowledge of tree growth rates.
- 5. Valid Driver's License with a clean driving record.
- 6. Ability to work independently.
- 7. Strong verbal and written communications skills.
- 8. Ability to work in rugged terrain and inclement weather.
- 9. Ability to read and follow maps.
