ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- ◆ Enrolled or accepted for enrollment at a qualifying educational institution
- ◆ Completed high school or have a GED
- ◆ Be in good academic standing with a cumulative 2.0 grade point average
- ◆ Provide transcripts & proof of enrollment/acceptance letter
- ◆ Provide detailed resume showing your suitability for this position
- ◆ U.S. Citizenship required
- ◆ 18 years of age or older

A summary of the positions/sections:

- Visitors Assistance (VA) - The Visitor Assistance Program enforces rules and regulations on federal grounds through the use of Title 36. VA staff members will assist campers with reservations and general inquiries.
- Recreation/Maintenance - The recreation team assists with the general upkeep of Mark Twain Lake, this includes three campgrounds, hunter-fisherman lots, boat ramps, two beaches, and three amphitheaters.
- Interpretative Services and Outreach Program (ISOP) - Consists of programs that provide education, historical interpretation, recreational and environmental improvements to the public.
- Environmental Stewardship - The mission of the program is to manage and conserve natural resources consistent with ecosystem management principles, while providing quality public outdoor recreation experiences to serve the needs of present and future generations.
