Make sure you select:

MCCALL, ID and YELLOWPINE, ID

as the duty location/preference.

BE SURE TO SELECT "LOCATION NEGOTIABLE" IF THERE IS THAT OPTION ON THE APPLICATION

It will be best to apply to ALL of these position Announcement #s in the event there are HR issues with getting on one of the preferred lists, which is very common. If you are referred to each of the lists, you will have a better chance of making it through the system and being able to be hired.

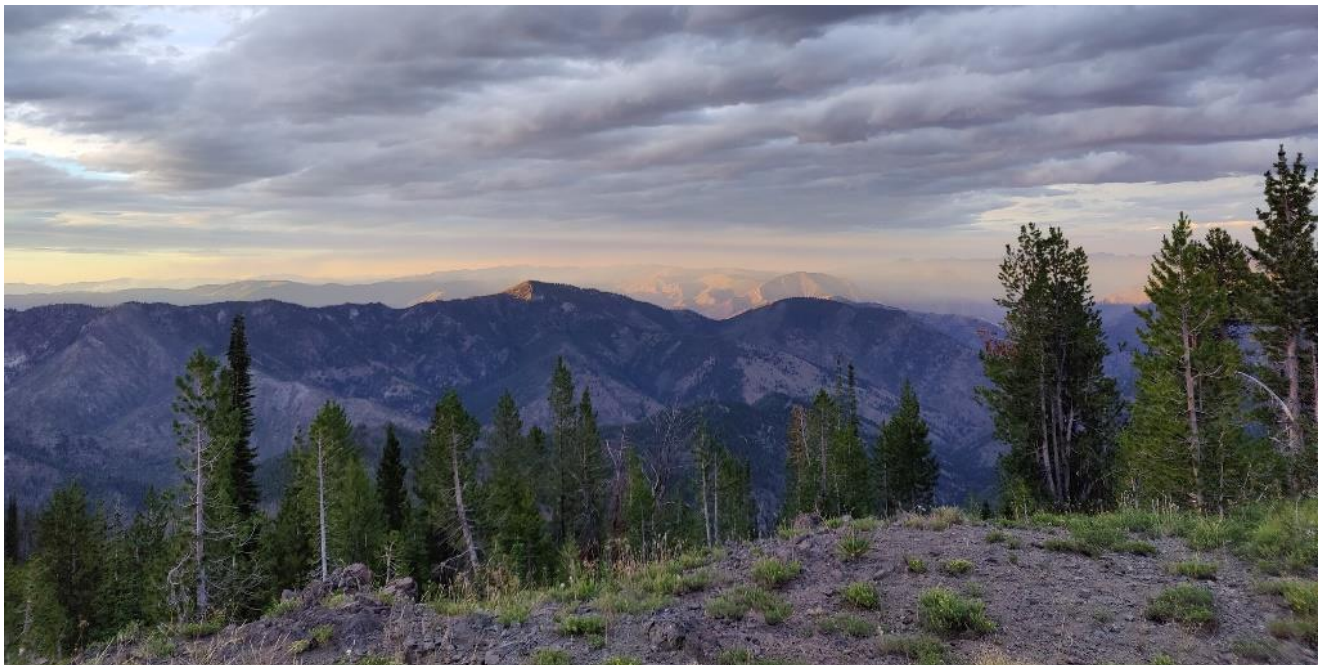
